### **Annual Report 1911**

The report of this time published the annual giving of all parishioners.

To-day this would indeed be frowned upon.

The largest contributor at this time was R.C.S. Kaulbach, who contributed \$59.00 to the operation of the parish. It is hard to imagine how much inflation has occurred. Some people were still paying pew rent amounting \$1.00-\$3.00. The total income of the parish amounted to \$3614.41 with an overdraft of \$380.44 at the Royal Bank. There was a special offering for vocal music from R.C.S. Kaulbach and W.C. Smith amounting to \$10.00. The Rector received \$1100.00, the Curate \$250.00, the Rev. Robinson at Blue Rocks received \$100.00. The Organist received \$320.00 and the Chimer \$68.75. The stipend for the Sexton was \$150.00.
