Another Royal Occasion: *Memorial Service*

On the morning of February 15th, 1952, a memorial service was held in St. John's Church for His Majesty King George VI whose passing was mourned by the entire country. The service was in charge of the Ven. R.G. Fowlow. The church was filled. The prayers were read by the Rev. Alexander Allen of the Presbyterian Church and the officer in command of the Salvation Army in Lunenburg. The lesson was read by the Rev. Mr. Bauls of Zion Lutheran Church and the sermon was taken by the Rev. Mr. Miller of Central United Church.
