BROTHERHOOD OF ST. ANDREW , DOMINION OF CANADA

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that St. John's Chapter of Lunenburg, N.S. Having duly ratified the Constitution of the Order, and fulfilled the requirements for admission set forth therein, is enrolled as Chapter No. 210. In witness whereof, this Instrument has been signed by the President and attested by the Secretary of the CANADIAN COUNCIL OF THE BROTHERHOOD OF ST. ANDREW. on this thirteenth day of February A.D. 1897.
