*The Silver Jubilee of King George and Queen Mary/ Monday May 6th*

The Service was held in St. John's Anglican Church at 11 a.m. Various organizations were present and the following received the King's Decoration of the Jubilee Medal: **Mr. and Mrs. Wm. Duff, M P, Mr. and Mrs. John J. Kinley, Mr. Wm. G. Hall, Dr. R. C. Zinck and Rev. W. E. Ryder.** Mayor A. W. Schwartz decorated the above. Rev. W. E. Ryder gave the address and conducted the service.

The Missionary Convention was held in this Parish on May 28<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> 1935.

There were over one hundred delegates present from various parts of the Province and P.E.I. The Meetings were very interesting, particularly to those engaged in the work of the W.A.
