

STORIES FROM THE RICH PAST OF OUR PARISH

In the year, 1889, the Church was altered and remodeled, the wings being built at a cost of nine hundred seventy five dollars. Mr. Frank Powers offered to put a steam heating system in the Church for fifteen hundred dollars or hot air for four hundred dollars. Both offers were refused and the wardens were authorized to buy two stoves at a cost of seventy dollars with ornamental pipe and drum. The parishioners must have been rugged.
