

## **STORIES FROM THE RICH PAST OF OUR PARISH**

In 1900 electric lights were finally installed. Ninety lights of 16 candle power were installed at a cost of one hundred and fifty dollars. (These were what to-day would be 40 watt lamps) It was estimated that the lights would cost seventy-five dollars per year, if used only for Sunday Services. If used for all services the cost would be one hundred twenty-five dollars per annum.

The vestry decided to retain the oil lamps and use them on days other than Sunday. It appears that the cost of electricity was a concern at this early date.
