The year 1902 was extremely busy period. The first church book or annual report, was printed. The wardens were not permitted to print the amount paid or subscribed by the various parishioners. The rectory was in a very dilapidated condition. The repairs cost over three thousand dollars.

An organ motor was installed to take the place of the blower (a person) who at that time was paid twenty-five dollars per year.

A remarkable presentation was made to the church. Mr. C.E. Kaulbach namely, a beautiful set of chime-bells. An illuminated address was presented to Mr. Kaulbach at a parish meeting held for the express purpose.
